As a Diocese, we are committed to our pastoral, biblical, insurance, legal and duty of care responsibilities. This includes implementing the recommendation from the Anglican General Synod in relation to safer ministry as underpinned by the Diocesan Code of Conduct: *Faithfulness in Service*, with the intended goal that all ministries are spiritually, emotionally and physically safe.

The five key statements in our Safe Ministry policy are:

1. Safe Recruitment
2. Adequate Training
3. Continued Supervision
4. Safe Environments
5. Safe to raise Concerns

Part of adequate training is attending a safe ministry awareness workshop including the implementation of Policy and Protocols of the Diocese.
