

Safe Ministry Diocesan Council 12th February 2021, Due Diligence Amendment

Dear Rectors and PSMA's, please note that while the current SM002:Due Diligence Protocol is still in force, from 23/02/2021 the following adjustment has been made.

Motion: That DC approve adjustment of the current SM002:Due Diligence Protocol, until such time as the fully revised protocol can be approved, to remove the requirement of a National Police check for current Category 2 workers except those who:

- i. are employees
- ii. perform a 'safe ministry role' as defined by the Safe Ministry to Children Canon 2017
- iii. perform a role prescribed by ordinance or canon
- iv. are required by a memorandum of understanding to provide a Police Check prior to appointment.
